When you write an essay or report, only use cohesive devices...

- 1...if you can use it correctly
- 2...if it is needed



Do not use too many cohesive devices.

Use a few (about 2 in each paragraph) in an effective, accurate, natural way.



Try to vary where, in the sentence, you put the cohesive device - don't always put it at the start of the sentence.



#### ADDING SIMILAR IDEAS

These words and phrases tell the reader that extra information is about to be added

in addition additionally also too

as well as furthermore moreover not only...but also

#### GVING EXAMPLES

These words and phrases tell the reader that examples are about to be given

for example for instance such as namely

to illustrate this

a good example of this is...



#### COMPARING SIMILAR IDEAS

These words and phrases tell the reader how two things are similar

## likewise similarly also

## in the same way equally



#### COMPASTING DEAS

These words and phrases tell the reader how two things are different

but however in contrast in comparison on the other hand on the contrary although even though

These words and phrases introduce an opinion

I agree with
I disagree with

These words and phrases introduce the causes of something

These words and phrases introduce the effects of something

These words and phrases introduce the reasons for something

#### SEQUENCING

These words and phrases help the reader to understand the sequence of items

firstly secondly next then

after that to begin with finally lastly

### After that, the numbers start to decline.

Firstly, I believe that governments must act to reduce CO2 emissions.



#### EMPASISING

These words and phrases help you to draw attention to an idea or example

particularly in particular especially specifically

certainly obviously in fact clearly

#### REFORMULATION

These words and phrases introduce the rephrasing of a previous idea

## in other words that is to say rather

in simple terms put more simply



#### CONCEDING DEAS

These words and phrases are for acknowledging another point-of-view

## admittedly on the other hand another view is

I concede that I admit that granted



#### CONCLUDING

These words and phrases introduce the conclusion of an essay
